Our goal is simple: make Kansas a place where life sciences companies can build, grow, and stay.

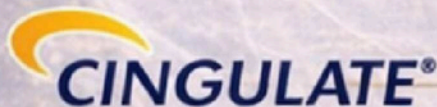

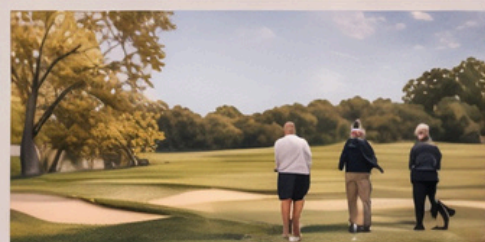
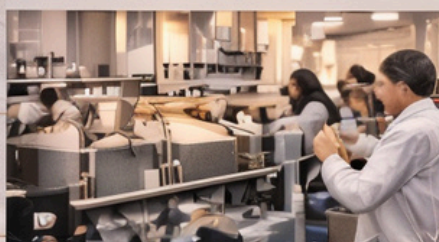
